First Grade + Fall = Fun!



First grade is such an exciting time in a child's life! They start read fluently, develop to critical thinking skills, and enhance their social skills. In first grade, we focus on developing the students' reading skills by teaching phonics and incorporating small group reading instruction into our day. We also increase their math skills

by integrating hands-on learning activities to enhance engagement. Each month, we focus on a "theme" to make learning fun for the students.

In October, we will be focusing on fall items which include apple tasting, pumpkin drawing, and learning the life cycle of a pumpkin. We recently kicked off our fall activities by learning about the famous "Johnny Appleseed." We read about his life and contributions, and then we created our own "Johnny Appleseeds" to hang in the hallway. When possible, we try to bring in as many subjects as we can during a lesson.

During our Johnny Appleseed discussions, we will integrate Social Studies (history of Johnny Appleseed), Science. (5 senses with the apple tasting), Math (we will make a bar graph of favorite apples), and Reading/Writing (the students will write in their journals as to why they picked the apple they did and something they learned about Johnny Appleseed).

Integrated learning is SO important in child's а education because they are able to make connections in many different ways. It is fun to see the "lightbulb" turn on when a child finally grasps a concept. We love to see the kids become excited to learn new things every day!



That's a Wrap! HCA's Fall Fundraiser a Success


