


Shake, Rattle, and Roll!

Celebrate the holiday season with everyone's favorite little orphan in her first adventure at HCA. There will be four performances: Thursday, 7pm; Friday, 7pm; Saturday matinee, 2pm; and a final performance Saturday evening at 7pm.

The title role of Annie will be shared by Lilly Kate Rogers and Anna Middleton Williams. Annie is determined to find her parents who abandoned her years ago on the doorstep of an orphanage run by the cruel Miss Hannigan, played by ViviAnn Johnson. Annie eventually foils Miss Hannigan's evil schemes, along with her evil brother Rooster (Max Dilello) and his girlfriend, Lily (Mabel Parker) by finding a new home and family with billionaire Oliver Warbucks (Ty Smoak), his personal secretary Grace Farrell (Anna Edwards), and a lovable mutt named Sandy (Nash Register).

Students will be performing such memorable tunes as "NYC," "You're Never Fully Dressed without a Smile," "Hard Knock Life," "Maybe," "Easy Street," "I Don't Need Anything but You," plus the eternal anthem of optimism, "Tomorrow." Based on the popular comic strip Little Orphan Annie and adapted from the Tony Award-winning Best Musical, with book and score by Thomas Meehan, Charles Strouse and Martin Charnin, *Annie Jr.* is directed by Marilyn St. Pierre, with choreography by Rebecca Retherford, and musical director, Faith Dearman.
